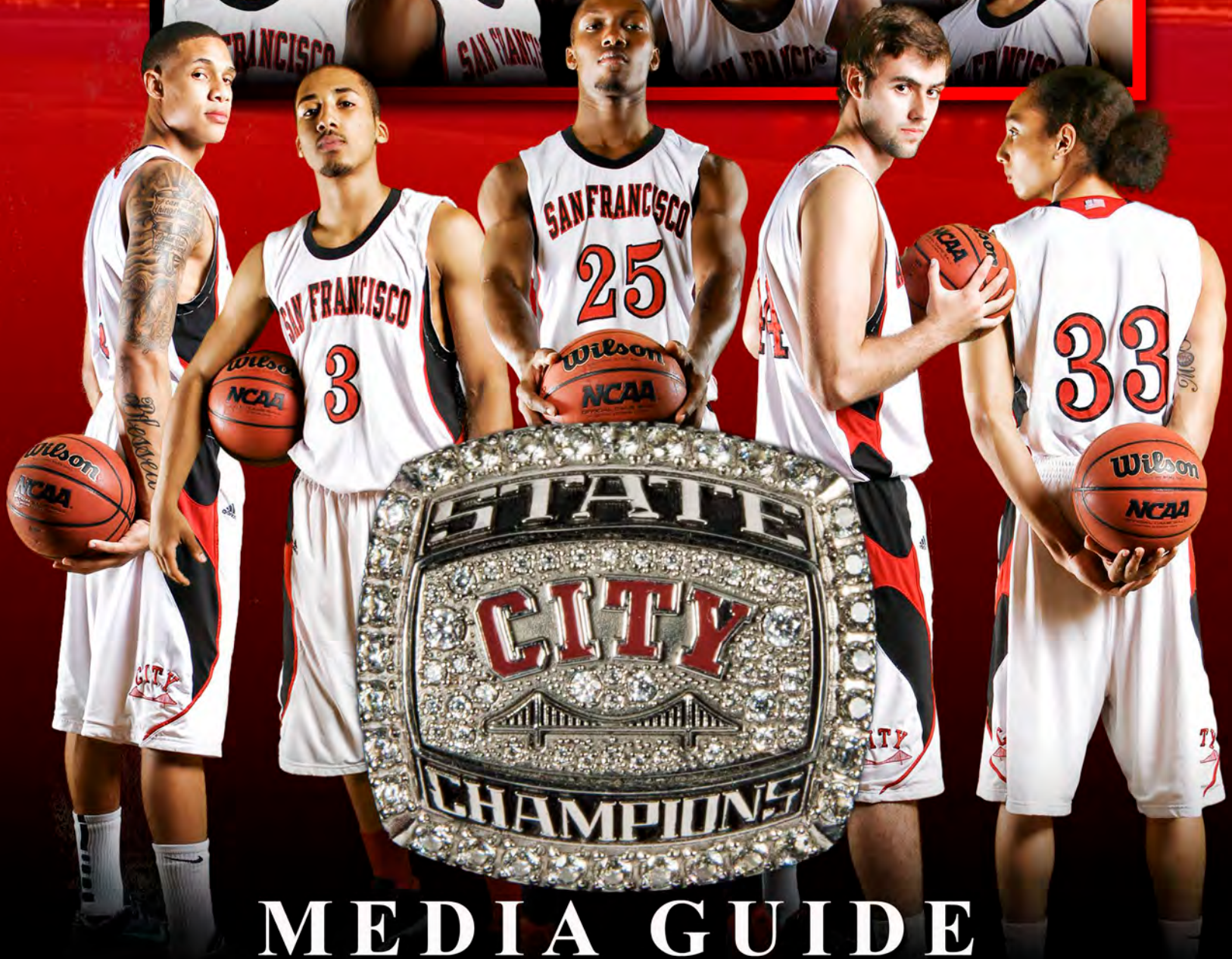

ALL HOME GAMES IN RED

Justin Labagh begins his ninth season with the City College of San Francisco Men's Basketball Program. In his first eight seasons at CCSF, Labagh has led the Rams to a State Championship, six Coast Conference Championships, a runner-up finish in the 2010 State Championship, two Final Fours, one final eight and three Sweet Sixteen's. Labagh's winning percentage here at CCSF is a whopping .856 with an overall record of 250-42. Not only did Labagh lead the Rams to five consecutive Coast Conference Championships through 2004-2009, but he has also been named California Coach of the year three times, 2005-2006, 2007-2008, 2010-2011. His program has graduated 23 players to Division 1 and 14 players to Division II.

Labagh is excited about the 2011-2012 as this year's squad has he returns three sophomores who played integral roles on last season's state championship team: Ivan Dorsey, Garrett Moon, and Myron Respress.

Like any other Ram team under Labagh, these sophomores played in the toughest schedule in the state. These sophomores won three pre-season tournaments last year on their way to producing one of the best seasons ever at City College of San Francisco, which enabled the Rams to win their first State Championship since 1962.

Joining Labagh's team this year are nine newcomers – Raysean Hairston, Thomas Cooper, Shawn Smith, McKenzie Moore, Delon Wright, Gabriel Aguirre, Stuart Wesonga, Jamal Ford, and Joseph Slocum. This year's team includes five former high school league MVP's, and nine All-League members.

Prior to becoming head coach of the CCSF men's basketball program, Labagh assisted the Rams for three years under coaches Harry Pantazopoulos and Patrick Springer. In 2000-2001, he completed an internship under then Texas Tech head coach, Bobby Knight. Labagh played college basketball at the University of California Berkeley where he was coached by Todd Bozeman and Ben Braun, and made two NCAA tournament appearances, including reaching the Sweet Sixteen in 1997. Former players Labagh played with at Cal were: Shareef Abdur-Rahim of the Sacramento Kings, Sean Marks of the New Orleans Hornets, Francesco Elson of the Denver Nuggets, Michael (Yogi) Stewart of the Atlanta Hawks, Ed Gray of the Atlanta Hawks, Tremaine Folks of the Indiana Pacers, Sean Lampley of the Miami Heat and Tony Gonzalez of the Atlanta Falcons.

The 34 year-old Labagh resides in his hometown of San Francisco with his wife Layla, and their two kids, Steele (4), and Soheila "Soli" (2).
